### **ORIENTAL THEATRE**

Since 2018, Milwaukee Film has operated this historic cinema, compleed over \$10 million in restorations, and is now celebrated as a treasured landmark on the National Register of Historic Places.

This one-of-a-kind movie palace, featuring three screens (including a 1,000-seat auditorium and a fully restored 1925 Wurlitzer pipe organ), provides the perfect venue for unique film screenings, large-scale corporate and community engagements, and group outings.

In 2023 alone, the Oriental Theatre welcomed **over 116,750 attendees** to the historic cinema. In Milwaukee Magazine's "2024 Best of Milwaukee" the Oriental Theatre notably won **Best Moviegoing Experience.** 







### **DOWNER THEATRE**

Established in 1915, the Downer Theatre is Wisconsin's oldest operating movie theater.

Milwaukee Film proudly took over operations of the Downer Theatre in April 2024. A number of key improvements were made to the venue, such as:

- New screen and masking panels
- · New projector and valance curtain
- New concessions equipment and offerings
- · Digital infrastructure and wiring to support projection booth functionality

And more improvements to come! Milwaukee Film is proud to now operate TWO historic cinemas within a mile of each other, a rare feature for any city, offering an **expanded experience for our patrons and fostering stronger community connections on Milwaukee's East Side.** 







### MILWAUKEE FILM FESTIVAL

At the heart of Milwaukee Film is the annual Milwaukee Film Festival, one of the largest film festivals in the country.

Over the duration of the 2024 15-day festival, the energy and momentum were tangibly felt by audiences and the community at large, with attendance of 32,624 across screenings and events. In Milwaukee Magazines "2024 Best of Milwaukee" the Milwaukee Film Festival notably won Best Arts/Entertainment Event.

"This year's festival was a joyous celebration of independent and international cinema," noted Cara Ogburn, Milwaukee Film's artistic director. "From a packed Downer cinema on a sunny day to watch Frederick Wiseman's latest to the return of our 500 person dance party for Stop Making Sense, the festival felt like a true **celebration of cinema and community**," she enthused.

- **301 Films:** 132 feature films, including 62 documentary features and 70 fiction features, and 169 short films. Over 55% of feature films were directed by women or nonbinary filmmakers.





#### **FESTIVAL ATTENDEE STATISTICS:**


